State Government has recently sanctioned 39 posts of District Judges (Super Time Scale) in the pay scale of 70290—1540—76450 for manning the same number of Family Courts in the State. Out of these specially sanctioned posts, 20 posts are for the current financial year i. e. 2013-14 and remaining 19 posts are sanctioned for the next financial year 2014-15. In this way we will be having Family Courts in the all Civil District of the State. Notification regarding establishment of 20 courts, sanctioned for this financial year, is to be issued by the State Government. Earlier we have 19 Family Courts in the 10 Divisions Headquarters of the State and 01 each at district (Rajgarh) & Tikamgarh.

(b) Category 3 (1) (b) — District Judge in Selection Grade Scale (Rs. 57700—1230—58930—1380—67210—1540—70290)

The number of posts in category (b) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 3 shall be 25% of the total number of cadre posts in the service i.e. 25% of 381=95.25 =95 posts.

Provided that the number of posts in categories (iv), (v) and (vi) taken together in the cadre of Senior Civil Judge shall be 40 percent of the total number of posts in the cadre of Civil Judges.

Vide Law Deptt. O. No. 589/21-B/(one) dated 10-02-2011, 1 posts of A.C.J.M. and 1 post of A.D.J., were sanctioned. These posts were sanctioned for trial of cases under M.P.S.I.D.C. cases Accordingly, 1 post is added in the cadre of Senior Civil Judge.

The State Government has created 86 new posts of Civil Judges (Entry Level), vide LD. O. No. 3(B)/1/2013-21 B(one) dated 15-02-2013. Against the said 86 posts, 35 posts (i.e. 40% of the cadre of Civil Judges are for Senior Civil Judges and remaining 51 are for Civil Judges (Entry level). 86 new posts sanctioned recently are **to be included** in the cadre of J.S., as issuance of Notification of these new posts is under process.
